

# RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

**Admission is granted and entries accepted only on these terms.  
Anyone not complying with these rules may be asked to leave.**

- The organisers accept no liability for accidents to competitors, spectators, animals or equipment and shall not be responsible for any loss, injury or damage. A condition of entry is that all competitors have a minimum of third party public liability insurance cover.
- The judge's decision in all cases is final.** Any objection must be made in writing within 20 minutes of said offence to the show organisers with a £20 deposit. The deposit will only be returned if the objection is upheld.
- In the interests of health and safety, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and obey the instructions of the organisers and stewards.
- Show jumping classes are held under BSJA rules.
- Riding hats to PAS015, BSEN1384 or any higher standard in force on the show date must be worn correctly fastened at all times when mounted.
- All times published are approximate and for guidance only.
- Ridden horses and ponies must be 4 years of age or older. **NO STALLIONS.**
- ABSOLUTELY NO telephone entries.**
- No entry fee will be refunded without a doctor's or vet's certificate and a stamped self-addressed envelope sent to the Entries Secretary.
- No galloping or lungeing on the show ground or in the car park.
- Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
- Please leave the parking areas clean and tidy: **ABSOLUTELY NO** mucking out of horse trailers/lorries and please remove **ALL** loose hay and droppings.
- The Organisers reserve the right to cancel the show, alter any judge, divide, amalgamate or close classes. In the event of cancellation, entry fees will be refunded, less £3 per rider to cover administration costs, within 28 days.

# RING 1 - SHOW JUMPING

9.00 am

**Class 1 2' 3" - The Lesley Flux and Lego Novice Jumping, Two phase**  
 Horse and rider combination not to have been placed first, second or third in a show jumping class.  
 Jumps will not exceed 2' 3" in the first round.  
*The Lesley Flux and Lego Memorial Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the highest placed WRC member.*

**Class 2 2' 6" - Jump for Jacob Novice Jumping, Two phase**  
 Horse and rider combination not to have been placed first, second or third in a show jumping class at this height.  
 Jumps will not exceed 2' 6" in the first round.  
*Jump for Jacob Memorial Perpetual Trophy to highest placed WRC member*

**Class 3 2' 6" - Take the Mickey Open Jumping, Two phase**  
 Jumps will not exceed 2' 6" in the first round.  
*Take the Mickey Perpetual Challenge Trophy to highest placed WRC member*

Not before 12.00 noon

**Class 4 2' 9" - The Cliff Barnes Open Jumping, Two phase**  
 Jumps will not exceed 2' 9" in the first round.  
*Cliff Barnes Perpetual Challenge Trophy to highest placed WRC member*

**Class 5 3' 0" - The Westbury Lad Open Jumping, Two phase**  
 Jumps will not exceed 3' 0" in the first round.  
*Westbury Lad Perpetual Challenge Trophy to highest placed WRC member*

**Class 6 3' 3" - The Alastair Tremlett Open Jumping, Table A3**  
 Jumps will not exceed 3' 3" in the first round.  
*Alastair Tremlett Perpetual Challenge Trophy to highest placed WRC member*

| <p><b>A STRICT ONE WAY SYSTEM IS IN OPERATION AT POLLY GLOVERS FARM, GU32 1JP.</b><br/> <b>All directions are suitable for lorries. Full details with a map are on the WRC website.</b></p> <p><b>From M3:</b> Leave M3 at J9 (from N) or J10 (from S). Follow signs to A272 Petersfield and drive on A272 for 4 - 5 miles. After Bramdean village take next R, signed Brockwood Park. After approx ½ ml, take first L turn. Follow this road across a crossroads, through an S-bend and the farm is on L with parking on R.</p> <p><b>On A32 from S:</b> Go on A32, through West Meon, to West Meon Hut (now Two for One) crossroads. Turn L on to A272 and go for 2 - 3 miles. Take second L, signed Brockwood Park. After approx ½ ml take first L turn. Follow this road across a crossroads, through an S-bend and the farm is on L with parking on R.</p> <p><b>On A32 from N:</b> On A32 at crossroads at West Meon Hut (now Two for One), turn R on to A272. Take second L (signed Brockwood Park). After approx ½ ml, take first L turn. Follow this road across a crossroads, then through an S-bend and the farm is on L with parking on R.</p> <p><b>From A3:</b> Leave A3 at A272 junction, signed to Winchester. If coming from N, do <b>NOT</b> take previous junction signed A272 Midhurst. Drive along A272 for approx 5 ml. Go over crossroads at West Meon Hut (now Two for One) on A272. Take second L (signed Brockwood Park). After approx ½ ml, take first L turn. Follow this road across a crossroads, through an S-bend and the farm is on L with parking on R.</p> |

## RING 5 - RIDDEN SHOWING

*Details of judges for all showing classes will be available on the website later.*

9.00 am

**Class 29 Best Conditioned and Turned Out Horse and Rider**

**Class 30 Best Family Horse/Pony**

May be split at 15.0 hh if sufficient entries.

*Jeanette's Engraving Perpetual Trophy to highest placed WRC member*

**Class 31 Riding Club Horse**

Judged on suitability as an all-round horse; may be asked to jump a small fence.

**Class 32 Riding Club Pony**

Ponies 14.2 hh and under. To be judged on suitability as an all-rounder. May be required to jump a small fence.

**Class 33 Ridden Mountain and Moorland**

Any height. May be split at 15.0 hh if sufficient entries.

Not before 2.00 pm

**Class 34 Best Ridden Veteran**

Horses and ponies 17 years or older.

Special rosette for the oldest combination of horse and rider.

*Softee Perpetual Trophy to highest placed WRC member*

**Class 35 Ridden Coloured**

Any height. Skewbald, piebald and tri-colour only.

*Original Jupiter II Perpetual Trophy to highest placed WRC member*

**Class 36 Ridden Cob or Cob Type**

Any height. *Alfie Perpetual Trophy to highest placed WRC member*

**Class 37 Ridden Arab or Part-Bred Arab**

Open to pure-bred, part-bred and Anglo Arab mares and geldings. Special rosette to highest placed pure-bred.

## RING 2 - SHOW JUMPING

9 – 11.30 am **CLEAR ROUND JUMPING**

£3 a round with a rosette for a clear round. Pay on the day.  
Height approximately 2' 0". Jumps may be raised at 10.30 am.

11.30 am

**Class 7 1' 6" Minimus Jumping, Riders may be led**

This class is to give confidence and encouragement to true beginners of any age: jumps will not exceed 1' 6" in the first round. Horse and rider combinations not allowed in any jumping class in Ring 1 or to have won any jumping class other than Minimus.

**Class 8 2' 0" Minimus Jumping, Off Lead Rein**

Jumps will not exceed 2' 0" in the first round.

Horse and rider combinations not allowed in any jumping class in Ring 1.

**Class 9 2' 3" – 2' 6" Open Scurry Jumping**

Jumps 2' 3" – 2' 6", one round against the clock, + 5 sec per knock down.

**Class 10 2' 6" Speed Pairs Relay**

First rider rides the course and passes whip to the second who then rides the same course. Timed from the first rider jumping the first jump to the second rider crossing the final jump, 5 sec added for each knock down.

***After Class 10 this ring will be open for Clear Round Jumping.***

## RING 3

### RIDDEN SHOWING and WORKING HUNTERS

*Details of judges for all showing classes will be available on the website later.*

9.00 am

**Class 11 Riding Horse**

Will be split at 15.2 hh if sufficient entries.

**Class 12 Racehorse to Riding Horse**

Competitors judged on short individual show (max 3 min) with optional jump.

**Class 13 Ridden Hunter (Spinal Research Charity Class)**

Will be split at 15.2 hh if sufficient entries. Will be ridden by the Judge.  
*Spinal Research rosettes to first 6 competitors and all proceeds from this class will go to Spinal Research Saddle Up Campaign*

**Class 14 Novice Working Hunter**

Jumps 2' 6" approx, this class is open to horses over 15.0 hh never to have been placed first, second or third in a Working Hunter Class. Will be ridden by the Judge.

**Class 15 Open Working Hunter**

Jumps 2' 9" approx, for horses over 15.0 hh. Will be ridden by the Judge.

Not before 2.00 pm

**Class 16 Novice Working Hunter Pony**

Jumps 2' 3" approx, this class is for ponies 15.0 hh and under, never to have been placed first, second or third in a Working Hunter Pony Class.

**Class 17 Open Working Hunter Pony**

Jumps 2' 6" approx, this class is open to ponies 15.0 hh and under.

**WORKING HUNTER CHAMPIONSHIP**

**Open to first and second places from Classes 13 – 17.**

***Rum Baba Perpetual Challenge Trophy to highest placed WRC member***

## RING 4 - IN HAND SHOWING

*Details of judges for all showing classes will be available on the website later.*

9.00 am

**Class 18 In Hand Young Stock -** Open to 1, 2 and 3 year olds

**Class 19 In Hand Best Condition**

Class split, If sufficient entries. Please state on entry form if stable (S) or grass (G) kept. Special rosette to highest placed horse/pony kept entirely at grass.

**Class 20 In Hand Mountain and Moorland -** Any height.

**Class 21 In Hand Coloured -**

Any height; skewbald, piebald and tri-colour only.

**Class 22 In Hand Cob or Cob Type -** Any height.

**Class 23 In Hand Veteran -** Horses and ponies 17 years or older.

## RING 4 - CHILDREN'S CLASSES (14 years and under)

Not before 1.00 pm

**Class 24 Best Child Handler**

Judged on child's ability to show his/her pony in hand. Conformation will not be taken into account. Rosettes to all competitors.

**Class 25 Lead Rein – Non Show Type**

Riders 9 years & under. Snaffle bridles only. Judged purely on suitability as a child's lead rein pony, not on conformation. Rosettes to all.

**Class 26 Child's First Pony**

Ponies 13.2 hh and under, suitable for beginners. Riders 12 years and under. Snaffle bridles only. No spurs.

**Class 27 Best Junior Rider**

Special rosette to best rider 10 years and under.

**Class 28 Pony the Judge Would Most Like to Take Home**

Open to all; no restrictions. Rosettes to all competitors.
