

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Admission is granted and entries accepted only on these terms.
Anyone not complying with these rules may be asked to leave.

- The organisers accept no liability for accidents to competitors, spectators, animals or equipment and shall not be responsible for any loss, injury or damage. A condition of entry is that all competitors have public liability insurance cover.
- The judge's decision in all cases is final.** Any objection must be made in writing within 20 minutes of said offence to the competition organisers with a £20 deposit. The deposit will only be returned if the objection is upheld.
- In the interests of health and safety, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and obey the instructions of the organisers and stewards.
- Riding hats to PAS015, BSEN1384 or any higher standard in force on the show date must be worn correctly fastened at all times when mounted.
- All times given are approximate and for guidance only.
- Horses and ponies must be 4 years of age or older. **NO STALLIONS.**
- No entry fee will be refunded without a doctor's or vet's certificate and a stamped self-addressed envelope sent to the Entries Secretary.
- Please leave the parking areas clean and tidy. Please remove **ALL** loose hay and droppings and **ABSOLUTELY NO** mucking out of horse trailers and lorries.
- In the event of cancellation, entry fees will be refunded, less £3 per rider to cover administration costs.
- This event is loosely based on the official BHS rules for TREC competitions. Unlike an official competition there is no compulsory list of items to be carried, but all horses must wear a headcollar and lead rope for the PTV Phase of the event.**

THIS EVENT WILL CONSIST OF 3 PHASES

1 CG – Control of Paces – max 60 points

In this phase there will be a marked corridor 2 m wide and approx 100 m long. The idea is to canter as slowly as possible along the corridor and then walk back as fast as possible. This phase carries a max of 60 points – no points are scored if you break pace or step outside the corridor.

2 PTV – Cross Country Obstacle Course

This is like riding a hunter trial course (at a leisurely pace) with a variety of obstacles along the way. Each obstacle is marked out of 10 points awarded for effectiveness and style. You are not eliminated if you do not complete an obstacle, but carry on and complete the course. There are penalties for exceeding the time limit.

Examples of obstacles are: jumping a log, hedge or ditch, leading your horse up or down a slope/step or over a ditch, mounting from the right-hand side from the ground, water crossing, bending poles, rein back between poles, immobility (horse must stand alone in enclosed area for 10 sec without moving).

Instructions for completing the obstacles will be sent to you, together with your start times for each phase, in the week before the competition.

3 POR – Optimum Speed and Orienteering – max 240 points

You will copy the route from the master map onto your own map (provided on the day). Allow 5 – 10 min to do this before you get ready to start. You will then leave the venue at your start time at a speed given to you at the start.

You will pass through a number of checkpoints where you will be given a new speed to ride at and may be held for a few minutes (in order to separate competitors). The speeds set will be between 6 and 12 kph. This phase carries 240 points, with penalty points deducted for not keeping to the set speeds or the exact route given.

This phase will not require any complicated orienteering skills, just a bit of simple map reading. Map marking pens, a map case and a compass may be useful but not essential.

CLASS 1 - INDIVIDUAL INTRO

Min age 16 - younger competitors can compete only as a pair with an adult.
For competitors who have not competed in a BHS affiliated Trec Competition.

CLASS 2 - INDIVIDUAL OPEN

Minimum age 16 years

CLASS 3 - PAIRS INTRO

Competitors in this class complete the first 2 phases individually, then ride together for the orienteering. Please enter together on the same entry form. Neither of the competitors to have competed in BHS Trec Competition.

CLASS 4 - PAIRS OPEN

Competitors in this class complete the first 2 phases individually, then ride together for the orienteering. Please enter together on the same entry form.

ENTRY FEES

WRC members: £16 per rider Non members: £20 per rider

Please include a self addressed C5 envelope with a first class stamp for your times and/or results.

ENTRIES WILL BE LIMITED.

**Closing date for RECEIPT of entries: Friday 28 August.
Late entries, at £5 extra per entry, will be accepted if there are spaces.**

Starting times for each phase will be sent out during the week before the competition.

Final results for all 3 phases will not be available on the day of the competition, but will be sent out afterwards.

The venue will be signposted from the A33 between Winchester and Basingstoke.
