

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Admission is granted and entries accepted only on these terms.
Anyone not complying with these rules may be asked to leave.

- The organisers, the landowner and his agents shall not be responsible for any loss, injury or damage to competitors, onlookers, their property, servants or horses or ponies howsoever caused on the premises. **A condition of entry is that all competitors have a minimum of third party public liability insurance.**
- The judge's decision in all cases is final. Any objection must be made in writing within 20 minutes of the said offence to the show organisers accompanied by a £20 deposit. The deposit will only be returned if the objection is upheld.
- In the interests of health and safety everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and to obey the instructions of the Organiser and the Stewards.
- Show jumping classes are held under BSJA rules.
- Riders must wear riding hats to PAS 015, BSEN 1384 or any higher standard in force on the show date at all times.
- Ridden horses and ponies must be 4 years old or over. **NO STALLIONS.**
- No entry fee will be refunded without a doctor's or vet's certificate and a stamped, self-addressed envelope sent to the Entries Secretary.
- Absolutely NO telephone entries.
- NO galloping or lungeing on college premises.
- **NO DOGS are allowed on the College premises.**
- The Organisers reserve the right to cancel any show, alter classes and refuse any entries without explanation. In the event of cancellation, entry fees will be refunded within 28 days, less £3 per entry form to cover administration costs.
- Please leave the parking areas as you found them. This means **ABSOLUTELY NO** mucking out of trailers or lorries and please remove **ALL** loose hay, straw and droppings.
- Horses and ponies must not be tied up outside horseboxes or trailers and left unattended.

CLASSES

Start: 9 am prompt - Class 1 course walk: before 9 am

- CLASS 1 SANTA'S SCURRY** (*Start times will be emailed and on the website.*)
Fences 60 cm (approx 2' 0") For rider / horse combinations not to have been placed first, second or third in a show jumping class
Riders pick up a small parcel, ride the course and post the parcel down a chimney, with 5 sec added for each knock down. Fastest round wins.
- CLASS 2 CREAKING CRACKER STAKES**
Fences 70 cm (approx 2' 3"), Two phase.
Riders must be 40 years and over.
- CLASS 3 LITTLE AND LARGE PAIRS RELAY**
For 2 riders / 2 horses: First pair jumps a 60 cm (2' 0") course, hands the whip to the second pair who jump a course of up to 75 cm (2' 6").
Special rosette to highest placed parent and child combination.
- CLASS 4 CHRISTMAS TREE STAKES**
Fences 75 cm (approx 2' 6"), Two phase
Special rosette to highest placed junior aged 14 years or under.
- CLASS 5 RUDOLPH'S RED NOSE STAKES**
Fences 85 cm (approx 2' 9"), Two phase
Special rosette to highest placed 'golden oldie' aged 40 years or over.
- CLASS 6 SNOWMAN'S SCURRY** (for the April Moon Challenge Trophy)
Fences 85 cm (approx 2' 9"), Timed, 5 sec added for each knock down.
Perpetual trophies given by Himoon Stables for first place and best WRC member, sash to winning horse and trophies for first, second and third.
- CLASS 7 HOLLY AND IVY STAKES**
Fences 95 cm (approx 3' 0"), Two phase
Special rosette to highest placed rider who has not competed in a show jumping competition at this height before. The Alastair Tremlett Memorial Cup will be awarded to the highest placed WRC Member.
- CLASS 8 MISTELTOE STAKES**
Fences 100 cm (approx 3' 3"), Table A3
Special rosette to highest placed rider who has not competed in a show jumping competition at this height before.
