WRC Committee Members Tell All!!

WE PUT THE SPOTLIGHT ON ANITA FRANCIS . .

- 1. What was your first pony/horse called and what was it like?
 The first pony I had at 12 years old was called Robbie, a 14.2 hh chestnut part bred Arab. He lived in the field next door to us. Robbie was a rebel and often difficult to catch. Very often I would return home disappointed as he had given me the slip for hours on end. I used to hack him for miles and miles, I loved the freedom of it just being him and me.
- 2. Were you a Pony Clubber? If so, which one and what did you do?
 I was never a Pony Clubber, but experienced it vicariously through my daughter and her pony. However I attended adult camp at Three Maids Chasers last year and am nervously looking forward to taking Bubble again in 3 weeks' time.
- 3. What has been your best horsy moment?
 I am a nervous rider, so my best horsey moments are not momentous wins. I have only competed at the WRC Autumn Show once and came sixth in a ridden show class. At this stage a victory for me is feeling I have done well in my lessons.
- 4. What was your worst horsey moment?
 Worst horsey moments, gosh, there have been plenty. Robbie jumping a 5 bar gate, the girth straps snapped. I fell off and watched him gallop off over the M27 motorway bridge. Or, arriving at our first Pony Club rally, to unload the pony in a field knee deep in grass, he pulled his head forward, the lead rein ran through my hand and he galloped off not a great first impression of us!
- 5. Have you got a horse at the moment and what do you do with it? The horse I have had since last September is Bubble, a 16.1 hh liver chestnut ISH X Warmblood. Bubble was bought for my daughter, but at 15 she decided to give up riding and take up a different social life, so I have taken him on. Thus far I have enjoyed Lizzie Murray dressage clinics and David Thomas show jumping clinics. I love hacking him out and enjoy sponsored rides. We now have a school at our yard which I will be making good use of practising what I have learnt in the clinics.
- 6. When did you last fall off and how did it happen?
 The last time I fell off was out on a hack on my own. Half a mile from home, slowly cantering along, all of sudden Bubble leapt sideways and I was on the floor. I try not to think about falling off and prefer not to talk about it when I am riding. I need to think positively,

as I am very aware the horse I have has much more experience than me and thinks quicker than me. Damage limitation through lots of lessons and clinics is paying off and I am looking forward to entering lots of events with him.

- 7. Have you ever arrived at an event and forgotten something crucial?

 So far I have always managed to be organised for the very occasional event I have been to. For Pony Club, I actually had a laminated sheet with a list of everything we needed on it which I would double check before we set off. Pony? Check!
- 8. What's the biggest thing you have ever jumped?
 The biggest unsuccessful jump was the 5 bar gate on Robbie when I was 12. More recently on Bubble, I successfully managed the much smaller gate at the top of the hill at Dene Farm. My jumping is very hit and miss. If David Thomas is talking me through every stride, I can manage to get round. Left to my own devices it is very up and down!
- 9. Do you have a lucky mascot or charm or something you always have to do before a competition? I don't have any lucky mascots. I just try to make sure I am as comfortable as possible. The first time I hunted my socks got all ruffled up and my legs got really sore!
- 10. What is the best bit of kit you have ever had and could not be without?

 My best bit of kit is my full seat "sticky bum" jodhpurs. I have a very nice Ariat pair, but my super sticky ones were from Robinsons, so sticky I could barely get off the leather seat in my car! Sadly, I have worn them out and they don't stock them anywhere anymore. I have even thought of unpicking the seat and sewing it onto a less sticky pair!
- 11. Where is your favourite venue/centre and why?
 I enjoy Sparsholt as a venue, it's easy to get to. I have sussed out where to park without being boxed in and I am familiar with it. Even in summer I take plenty of layers and a warm hat. It is without doubt the coldest place on earth!
- 12. Who is your hero/heroine rider?

 My hero as a child was David Broome, always so calm, unlike me, so excited to be allowed to stay up late and watch Horse of the Year show. Today the young heroine I follow is Emily King, an exciting young hopeful for the future.
- 13. What horse would you love to own and why?

 I love a grey or a coloured so Jane Winson's Murphy or Gemma Hamilton's Humphrey are 2 riding club horses I covet.
- 14. Why and how did you get involved with the Riding Club Committee?

 I was invited to join the committee by Becky Herbert as someone was needed to take over from Deborah Smyth to update the website. Becky was also the person who found me my first horse, William, after a 25 year break from riding. My husband says she has a lot to answer for!
- 15. What do you like best about Winchester Riding Club?
 I love Winchester Riding Club as the training and events are ones I can join in without feeling intimidated and everyone is so encouraging and friendly. I really hope I can be of use to the Club. I don't have masses of equine knowledge, but I do really love seeing people enjoying their horses and ponies and look forward to being a part of that.
- 16. What is your day job?

 I have had various careers, secretarial roles, 12 years as cabin crew, but now my day job is running a children's day nursery and before and after school club.

So You Want to be a Dressage Diva? DO's and DON'Ts

This is aimed at grass roots entry level, Intro and Prelim participants, or anyone thinking of participating who may not be familiar with the rules and expectations.

DO remember that **ALL** dressage competitions, even unaffiliated Riding Club ones, are run under British Dressage (BD) rules, so try to familiarise yourself with the basic rules about what is not permitted under BD rules. You can visit the BD website or get a rulebook for £5.

STEWARDS

Some competitions are self stewarding, so there is no steward at the warm-up telling you when to go to your test and what you can or cannot wear. **YOU** are responsible for presenting yourself at the correct time and in the correct manner. When there is a steward, make yourself known to them when you enter the warm up so that they know you are there. Then they can warn you when it is near your time to go to your competition arena – but it is not their responsibility to make sure you get there on time – it is yours. They may also not be able to tell you if you and your horse are correctly attired.

NUMBERS

If you have a bridle number disc holder and numbers, wear your number on your bridle. This makes it easier for show officials to identify you. If not, there may be numbers to pick up at the Secretary's table. If there are no numbers, you simply tell everyone who you are when you enter the warm-up and competition arenas. It is a matter of common courtesy to acknowledge the judge and writer when you enter an arena. The arena belongs to the judge while (s)he is officiating - you are entering her/his office!

BOOTS, MARTINGALES, NECKSTRAPS

In the warm-up you may have **boots/bandages** on your horse's legs, but take them off before you enter the competition arena. They are **NOT** permitted in a test.

Martingales connected to the reins are not permitted at all, even in the warm-up, neither is any form of draw reins or balancing reins.

Neckstraps are allowed on young horses in Intro and Prelim classes, but not Novice or higher level classes.

BRIDLES

Permitted: Black or brown leather snaffle bridles for Intro, Prelim and Novice. The bridle must have a noseband and a browband, (yes, the browband can be bling!), and a single set of reins taken over the horse's head and looped over the top of the horse's neck.

Micklem bridles are permitted. Cavesson, flash, drop nosebands are permitted.

Not Permitted: Western style or Arab showing bridles are not permitted.

BITS

Permitted: Single and double jointed snaffle bits: eggbut, loose ring, D-ring, hanging cheek (Baucher), Fulmer.

Not Permitted: Pelham bits, Waterford bits, bits with slots or extra rings that fix the reins.

Bit guards (the rubber rings between the bit and mouth).
